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THIS PODIUM IS MY HOME by Jan Matar (Syria)



This documentary by Jan Matar follows the participants of the first FATE project at ZID Theater, that took place between November 2020 and November 2022.

This documentary focusses on the last - the two-year trainings program. Specifically, the second phase of creating a theatre production with the participants, at ZID Theatre in Amsterdam. After a year of physical training and theoretical development with a bigger group, ten participants went on to create their own play 'NO FEAR'. It premiered on May 11th during the International ExploreZ festival and toured through various dutch cities as well as in Spain. Learn about their experiences in this documentary.

Terra by DAH Theatre



The performance connects gardening, plants cultivation, land (*lat. TERRA*) with stories about migrations and immigrants. It contemplates effort, pain, and adjustment it takes to be “transplanted” during the process of migration, especially when that movement has been involuntary.

Apart from reminding the audience about the mass migrations we have been facing in the recent years (as well as earlier in history), the performance strives to awaken empathy with people that were “transplanted”, through movement, songs, contact with the plants, earth and water by actress and musician Ljubica Damčević. The performance includes videos in which documentary materials are interweaved just as the fates of emigrants.
